⑥ Hojo Sand Dune Coast and Wind Turbines

The coast of Hokuei Town, which borders onto the Sea of Japan, is a sandy beach that expands for 12.5km to the east and west. In summer, smelt fishing and dragnet fishing are popular here. Along the coastline there is a row of 100m-tall wind turbines, which stand as a symbol of Hokuei's policy of environmental friendliness.

Hokuei Town is busy with unique events, including a marathon that attracts runners from all across Japan, as well as events where you can meet Mr. Gosho Aoyama!



Suika-Nagaimo Kenko Marathon

This marathon competition has three courses, the 3km, 5km and 10km races, which pass through hillside fields of watermelon (suika) and yams (nagaimo), both specialty products of Hokuei Town, as well as sand dune fields. After clearing the goal, runners can eat their fill of watermelons and yam soup!

Yura Danjiri Festival

This festival originated with prayers for the safe passage of rice cargo ships and the safe loading of the annual rice tax during the Edo period. A portable shrine is paraded around the streets, with children and drums on top. Performed as one of the annual festivals of Takae Shrine.

The footsteps of our ancestors, and many of the cultural assets they left behind, are to be found in Hokuei Town. Come see and feel the lives and history of our ancestors!



② Remains of Mutsuo Reverberatory Furnace

This site holds the remains of one of the greatest blast furnaces in Japan, where iron cannons were cast at the end of the Tokugawa Shogunate. It was built and operated by the local samurai Takenobu Juntaro, with highly advanced technological prowess. If the furnace remained intact it would have a value comparable to World Heritage status, however, unfortunately only the earthen walls surrounding the site are preserved. The furnace is referenced in the motif on the exterior of the 'Gosho Aoyama Manga Factory'.

① Historic Site: Remains of Yura Battery

At the end of the Tokugawa Shogunate, this battery was built by the townspeople to protect the region from foreign forces. Constructed with advanced techniques, this is one of the few Western-style batteries in Japan whose original shape remains preserved.

③ Higashitakao Kannonji Temple



560 Higashitakao, Hokuei Town

A total of 45 Buddha statues are enshrined here, including two National Important Cultural Properties (a wooden Thousand-armed Kannon statue, and a wooden Eleven-faced Kannon Statue) and eleven Prefectural Protected Cultural Properties. Prior reservation required for visits. (Admission fee: 500 yen)

Encounter History that Remains Vivid

④ Hojo Hachiman Shrine

Enshrined on Mt. Hachiman, with a panoramic view of the Hojo Plain. Medieval samurai commanders are highly venerated here, and there is a *munafuda* (wooden tag commemorating the foundation of the shrine) dedicated by Tadayoshi Satomi. The shrine also has one of the oldest bells in the prefecture.

The temple's collection includes seventy-six paintings by Itsugyu Hikita on the lattice ceiling of the main hall, and a folding letter screen owned by Hioki Mokusen.

⑦ Grave of Zen Master Hioki Mokusen

The grave of the Hojoshima-born Zen Master Hioki Mokusen, who served as the abbot of Eihei-ji Temple and the head of the Soto Sect during the Taisho period.

⑧ Saio Residence

The parental home of Yoshikatsu Saio, who designed the 46cm-diameter main battery loaded on the battleship "Yamato".



⑨ Fujitake Residence

The home of Sakichi Fujitake, who was responsible for transportation of the feudal clan's rice, and traveled to Osaka and back by chartered ship.



⑩ Former Site of the Toyoda Residence

The former site of the house and gardens of Tazo Toyoda, who established Ikuiko, the first private school in the San'in region.



⑪ Saeki Residence

Formerly a high-class inn, which served as a *Honjin* (an officially-designated inn for the use of the *Daimyo* lord and other nobles).



⑫ Former Site of Yura Feudal Clan Storehouse

Built by the Tottori Clan as a storehouse for the clan's annual rice tax, it remains today as an Inari Shrine.



⑬ Endo Residence

The former mansion of an official in charge of rice inspection. Provided support for the establishment of the "Yura Danjiri" festival.



⑭ Saino Residence

Bearing the shop name of a blacksmith, a descendant of the swordsmithing Hiroyoshi Clan.



"Daiei Watermelons", one of the most popular and highly-reputed watermelon brands in the Japanese market, are large-size, high-quality watermelons with a high sugar content. The brand celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2007.

Sakyu Yams Season: Year-round

Sakyu ("Sand-dune") Yams, which grow to a rich length in the soft, sandy soil, are a highly nutritious food. "Nebarikko", a new glutinous variety crossbred from "Nagaimo" and "Ichoimo" yams, has recently debuted!



Sakyu Grapes Season: July to September

The marked temperature difference between the morning and evening, a distinctive characteristic of sand dune fields, produces superbly sweet grapes. Large-size varieties with sensational flavors, including "Kyoho", "Delaware", "Shine Muscat", and "Pione", are cultivated here.



Strawberries Season: December to June

Popular for their unique sweetness and tanginess, nurtured by Hokuei's naturally rich sand dune soil! Enjoy a wide range of varieties, including "Beni Hoppe" and "Akihime".

In business since 1865, this sake brewery has a deep relationship with the local area. Umetsu Shuzo respects the techniques handed down over time, and aims towards the creation of potent *junmai* (pure) sake. Among its flagship products are 'Junmai Hurray!', aimed at team supporters, the special *junmai* sake 'Umaigana', which is brewed by local volunteers, and 'Kimoto', created using a revival of traditional methods. In addition, 'Sakyu Nagaimo Shochu', made with local specialty yams, and 'Nokyo Ume Sake', made by steeping ripe *ume* plums of around 5-6cm in diameter in sake for two years, offer smooth and rich-bodied flavors.

We offer sake brewery tours and tastings.







The Distant Town(Kurayoshi)


"Haruka na Machi e" (To the Distant Town), a manga by Jiro Taniguchi, is set against the backdrop of Kurayoshi in the 1930s. The town's scenery, reminiscent of a bygone era, remains preserved in a peaceful stillness. The district of white-walled storehouses has been nationally designated as an important area of historical buildings for preservation.

Misasa Onsen(Misasa)

Misasa Onsen, one of the most famous hot springs of the San'in region, has long been regarded for its therapeutic benefits. Its waters, with one of the highest radon contents worldwide, are widely known for their "hormesis effect", which strengthens immunity and the body's natural self-healing abilities. It is famous for the open-air baths that line the sides of Misasa Bridge.

Lake Togo Yotsude-ami (Yurihama)

As one of San'in region's eight most beautiful views, Lake Togo is a brackish water lake, 12km in circumference. The shores of the lake contain attractions such as Hawai Onsen, Togo Onsen, and Enchoen, one of the largest Chinese-style gardens in Japan. The pleasant lake-side breeze is perfect for an enjoyable stroll. The large *shijimi* clams produced in Lake Togo are famous as "black diamonds".

Kanzaki Shrine (Kotoura)

The roof of the main hall is constructed in the *yatsumune-zukuri* ("eight-ridged") style, with exquisite carvings of flowers, birds and other fauna and flora decorating the edges from the underside of the roof. The spectacular dragons carved on the ceiling at the hall's entrance are a breathtaking sight for visitors.
